The 2022-2023 fiscal year saw an exciting buzz in our region as businesses began to start back up and begin to grow. This was a time for recovery and expansion. The Lakeland economic trends were towards retail, service industries, construction and transportation. We are home to 4 Wing Cold Lake Base which is revving up construction and production for the incoming F-35A fighter jets. This region will continue to grow as new military and carbon capture projects are being planned and completed. We worked hard at building awareness for our CF in the Lakeland and it is showing results as we have seen an increase in clients looking to CFL for business advisory services and resources.

This year we took on a new program, the SMARTstart Entrepreneur Program. SMARTstart is an excellent, 8 month entrepreneur training program that provides three main elements: online business training through GoForth, 11 inperson workshops dealing with every aspect of running a business – accounting, marketing, bookkeeping, business planning, insurance, etc. and the best part, mentorship – where the new entrepreneur is matched with a local established business owner who walks them through a business plan, feasibility study or strategic plan. Our SMARTstart program was sponsored and supported by all 3 of our municipalities, ECARIN, 7 participating entrepreneurs, 10 local business mentors, with another 15 local businesses being involved throughout. This is a business community building program, and we are excited to run for another session in the fall.

Some of the other projects that we worked on in this year included; **BDC and local banks** – Business Bankers Lunch, Economic development strategy planning through the Regional Economic Information Partnership (REIP), **Chamber of Commerce** events including - EARN, Business of the Year Awards, Christmas Craft Show, Feast at The Beach, Level Up Lakeland, **Municipality Partnerships** through – the Beautification Loan Program, SMARTstart, Lemonade Day,
